

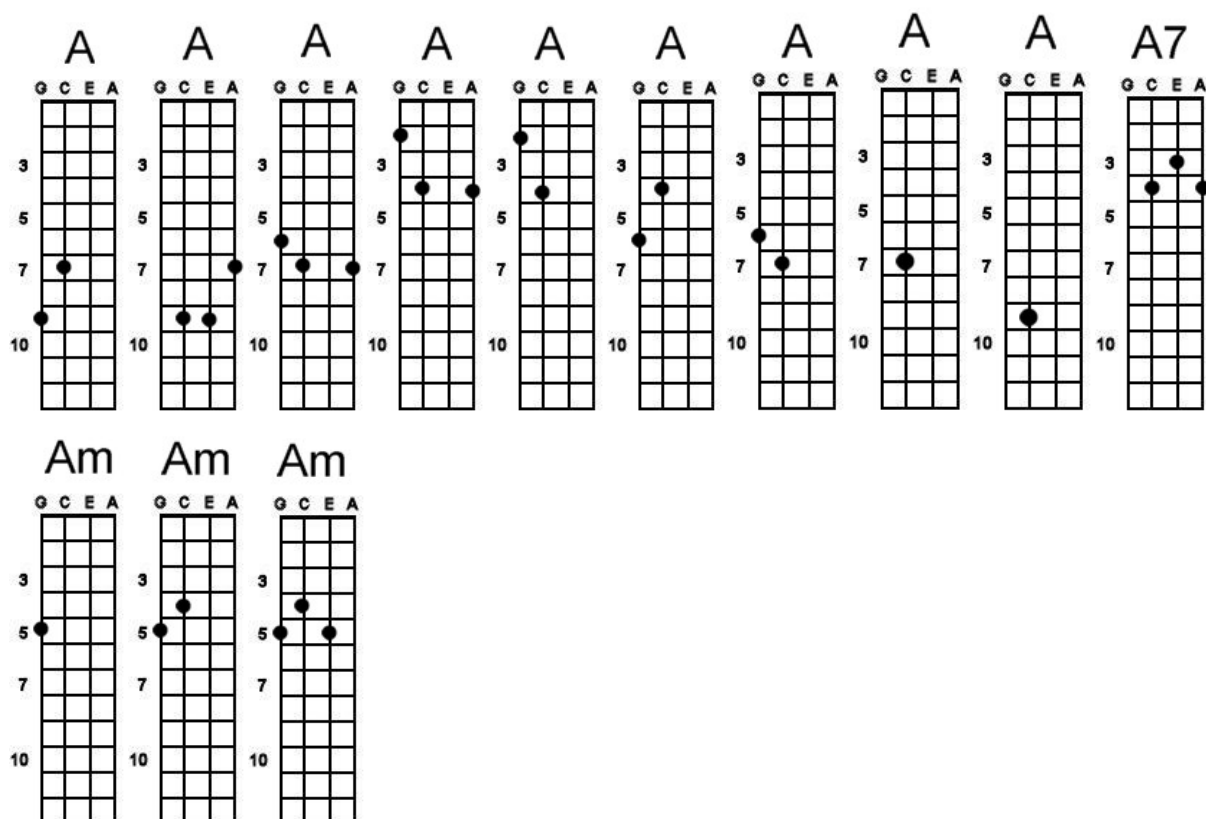
Secret Chords.....the chords that the books don't tell you about....
